A text message where young people can get confidential help and advice. School nurses offer advice and support about health and wellbeing, all kinds of things like emotional health, sexual health, relationships, alcohol and drugs and bullying.

How do I access the service?

To start a chat with your school nurse, just send a message to 07312 263 291.

Mersey Care NHS Foundation Trust has introduced a quick and easy way for your young people in to get in touch with their school nurse.

Those aged 11 to 19 can now send a text message to our school nurse for help and advice about all kinds of things like emotional health, relationships, alcohol and drugs and.

Young people can start a chat with our school nurse, by sending a message to 07312 263 291.

When they send a message, they'll get confirmation that the message has been received. A trained healthcare professional will reply between 9am and 4.30pm and within 24 working hours at most.

What if it's urgent?

If you need urgent help, you should visit an NHS walk-in centre or call NHS 111. In an emergency, dial 999 or go to A&E.

There will be posters and flyers around school advertising this new service and young people will be reminded in assemblies.
