Dear Parent/Carer

In line with Government policy, we will be involving children and their families in deciding how we can best use our resources to keep them healthy.

This term we are asking all children in school year 11 to complete a simple online questionnaire about their health, wellbeing, and lifestyle. The information we gather will also help us identify how we can support your child with any issues that may be impacting on their health and wellbeing.

Our Specialist Community Public Health Nurses (School Nurses) will look at all the completed questionnaires and may ask to meet with your child to talk about their responses in more detail. They will also be available to see any child who wishes to talk with them.

The information we collect will be used to tailor a bespoke public health plan for the school so that group health education sessions can be delivered.

We take the confidentiality of our patients and their carers very seriously and will only share person-identifiable information outside the Trust with the person's explicit consent unless, there is a legal reason to share without it.

We will record routine information about your child, such as their full name, address, date of birth, sex, ethnicity, details of their GP and school, as well as your details. The information will be held electronically or in a paper care record and will be stored securely.

The Trust's legal basis for collecting, using and storing information is to enable it to perform its public task in providing direct health care to its patients (and their carers where applicable).

If your child has a special education need (s) and or disability, please contact your school nurse to discuss the suitability of questionnaire for your child and how we can best support them to

complete if appropriate. The results of these questionnaires are looked at alongside your child's health record and will help us identify if further support is required.
